| EYFS       | Courage<br><b>Hope</b>  | <b>Noah's Arc</b><br><i>Noah and his family trusted God's promise that He would save them from the flood. The rainbow afterward became a symbol of God's promise and hope for the future.</i>  | Genesis 6.9 - 8.19 |
| Year 1     | Courage<br><b>Faith</b> | <b>David and Goliath</b><br><i>David's courage didn't come from his own strength but from his trust in God. While others were afraid, David believed that God would protect him and give him victory over Goliath. His faith gave him confidence to face what seemed impossible.</i> | Matthew 18:10-14   |
| Year 2     | Courage<br><b>Faith</b> | <b>Daniel in the Lion's Den</b><br><i>Daniel trusted God completely, even when obeying Him put his life at risk. He kept praying despite the king's command, showing unwavering faith, that God would protect him. And God did – by shutting the lions' mouths.</i>                  | Daniel 6.1-28      |
| Year 3     | Respect<br><b>Love</b>  | <b>The Parable of the Lost Sheep</b>   | Matthew 18:10-14   |

Jesus reminded them that being close to Him in love is the most important thing.</i></p>     | Luke 10:38-42     |
| Year 5       | <p>Empathy<br/><b>Faith</b></p>                                     | <p><b>The Feeding of the 5,000</b></p> <p><i>The disciples had to trust Jesus' power when there seemed to be too little food for such a huge crowd. Their faith, and Jesus' blessing, turned five loaves and two fish into enough for everyone.</i></p> | Matthew 14: 13-21 |
| Year 6       | <p>Ambition<br/><b>Hope</b></p>                                     | <p><b>Zacchaeus the Tax Collector</b></p> <p><i>His encounter with Jesus gave him hope for a new life. He saw that change was possible, forgiveness was offered, and he could make things right – a fresh start full of hope.</i></p>                   | Luke 19:1-10      |
| Whole School | <p>Courage<br/>Ambition<br/>Respect<br/>Empathy<br/><b>Love</b></p> | <p><b>The Parable of the Good Samaritan</b></p> <p><i>The Samaritan helped the injured man without expecting anything in return, showing selfless, kind, and practical love—just like God wants us to love one another.</i></p>                         | Luke 10: 25-37    |
